Adobe Illustrator is a graphics design and vector-based drawing application for print, multimedia, and online graphics. It differs from a raster based application like Photoshop which produce graphics with individual pixels. Unlike pixel graphics, vector graphics will remain sharp and crisp when exported for the web. With Illustrator, you can create anything from simple icon to complex digital drawing for infographics!
